This is in respect of National Injury Surveillance Centre established under the programme named as "Capacity Building for the developing trauma care facilities in Govt. Hospitals on National Highway" and the website URL for this NISC as www.nisc.gov.in

2. In this regard, it is informed that Injury Surveillance Data Capture Format and Burn Registry Format along with SOP's have been finalized by the Programme Division, Dte.GHS. At present NISC is collecting & compiling data from Central & State Govt. Hospitals and Medical Colleges of Delhi. Your Hospital was identified during 11th Five Year Plan under this programme and is reported to be functional. As per the norms of Govt. of India, online injury related data has to be submitted by all the hospitals to the Programme Division, MoHFW.

After receiving the nomination from state, final confirmation will be communicated by Programme Division to state for necessary action.
