

Development Partnership Administration-II (DPA-II) Division in Ministry of External Affairs is entrusted with the task of undertaking various capacity building programmes under Indian Technical and Economic Co-operation Programme (ITEC) of the Government of India. This also includes deputation of experts in different areas (agriculture, defence, healthcare, Ayurveda etc.) to ITEC partner countries on their requests.

2. In this regard, our Mission in Victoria (Seychelles) has received a proposal from the Govt of Seychelles for deputation of six medical specialists to Seychelles under ITEC programme.

3. As per ITEC norms, the experts would be paid a remuneration inclusive of Pay, Grade Pay plus the Foreign Compensatory Allowance depending upon their rank equivalence decided by the Ministry of External Affairs. Accommodation, local transport and medical facilities will be provided by the receiving Government as per the rank of the expert.

4. The experts will be deputed to Seychelles for a period of two years from the date of assumption of charge of the assignment. Duly filled-in ITEC forms, mentioning the description of the assignment, aims and objectives to be achieved through the proposed deputations, educational/technical qualifications required etc. are enclosed herewith.

5. The respective fields of the ITEC experts are mentioned as under:

i) Consultant Internal Medicine	2 Experts
ii) Consultant Medical Oncologist	1 Expert
iii) Consultant Ophthalmologist	1 Expert
iv) Consultant Rheumatologist	1 Expert
v) Consultant Surgeon/Laprosopic Surgeon	1 Expert
vi) Consultant Radiologist	1 Expert


6. India enjoys excellent bilateral relations with Seychelles, which is also a strategic partner. For a small country of population around 98,000 and given the serious constraints of medical services, many Seychellois national avail medical treatments in India. For a long time, Seychelles has been requesting for medical doctors from India to be deputed to Seychelles, given the lack of medical expertise available therein. The issue has also been raised in several High level exchanges between the two countries. The medical experts required, if deputed to Seychelles, would contribute in further enhancing our goodwill in Seychelles.

7. In view of the above, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare is requested to kindly take necessary action for nominating suitable medical experts who can be deputed to Seychelles at the earliest. This is especially important in view of the forthcoming Presidential visit from Seychelles from 22 - 25 June 2018.
