Opening Remarks

To welcome the members of the Local Managing Committee and Special invitees

Item No. 01 : **To confirm the minutes of the last meeting of Local Managing Committee held on 26th December, 2019**

The minutes of the Local Managing Committee held on 26th December, 2019 were circulated to all the members in advance. As no comments/suggestions were received on the same, the members are requested to kindly ratify the minutes and authorize Chairman to sign the same.

Item No. 02 : **To review the action taken on the minutes of the last meeting of Local Managing Committee held on 26th December, 2019**

All decisions taken in the last meeting of the Local Managing Committee held on 26th December, 2019 have been implemented.

Item No. 03 : **To inform regarding status of filling up the vacant position of elected members in the local managing committee**

Three members of Local managing committee are elected from amongst recognized teachers of MUHS and one member is elected from non-teaching staff on local managing committee. The earlier members, Dr. Manish Jain, Dr. A. Dhabarde, Dr. P. Zopate and Mr. Aote completed their 5 year term on 27th July 2020. Process for elections was started but as there was lockdown, permission from District Collector was sought, he has still not given permission to conduct the elections. Therefore it has been decided that the elections may be deferred till the time when the elections can be held smoothly.

Item No. 04 : **To consider and recommend the Annual Report of MGIMS for the year 2019-2020**

The Annual Report for the year 2019-20 in respect of Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences has been prepared and will be placed on the table. The members are requested to go through the same and are further requested to kindly consider and recommend the same to the Governing Council and Kasturba Health Society for adoption.

Item No. 05 : **To report about the special achievements of the Institute and faculty members**

Institutional Achievements

- The institute was awarded prestigious honor of 'Achievers of Maharashtra' by Sakal group. Shri Dhirubhai Mehta, President, Kasturba Health Society and Dr. S. P. Kalantri, Medical Superintendent received the award from the hands of Shri Nitinji Gadkari, Union Minister for Roadways.
- Kasturba Hospital has built a 200-bed dedicated Covid block that houses 30 ICU beds and 170 oxygen beds. The dedicated support staff is providing preventive, diagnostic, therapeutic and community-level care for patients affected with corona virus since May 2020.
- The Institute has established Covid laboratory on 27th April, 2020 in the department of Microbiology. The lab has been demarcated for sample collection, sample coding, sample processing and extraction room. All the samples are processed in Bio Safety level II Laboratory Lab receives samples from Wardha district and the reports are dispatched within 24 hours. Dr. Vijayshree Deotale, Director Prof and Head, Department of Microbiology is the Nodal person.
- A checklist prepared by the Department of Community Medicine as a self-assessment and action tool for preparedness at village level was accepted by the Central Ministry of Panchayat Raj and instructions were passed to all states for implementation.
- Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences has been ranked 23rd in All India Best Medical Colleges – The week Survey 2020 - conducted by Hansa Research and 1st amongst private colleges in West Zone of India.
- Kasturba Health Society appealed its employee to voluntarily contribute their one-day salary to strengthen the Centre's efforts to tackle the COVID situation soon after the Prime Minister urged organizations and individuals to donate money for the Prime Minister Relief Fund against the COVID-19 pandemic. 1077 employees of Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical sciences, Kasturba Hospital, Kasturba Nursing School and Kasturba Nursing College pledged their one-day salary to help government fight and on 04th June 2020, a cheque of Rs 19,20,648.00 has been handed over to Wardha Collector.

- On 11th May 2020, MGIMS sent a team of 45 doctors from 13 different specialties to lend a helping hand to the hospitals in Mumbai to provide care for the victims of COVID-19. This is the first incidence where Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) has sought help from outside Mumbai. Our residents served at Seven Hills Hospital, Andheri which is 800 bedded and the largest dedicated Covid-19 care facility in Mumbai for a period of two weeks.
- The Guardian Minister of Wardha district, Shri Sunil Kedar visited our hospital on 21st April, 2020 to oversee the preparations of COVID wards in our hospital.
- Former Chief Minister of Maharashtra and leader of the opposition Shri Devendra Fadnavis visited Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences (MGIMS), Sevagram on Wednesday 19th Aug 2020 to gather covid-19 related insights of the Kasturba Hospital-attached to MGIMS. He appreciated the efforts taken by the institute and its healthcare workers in tackling the pandemic.

Faculty Achievements

- Dr. BS Garg, Director Professor, Community Medicine received Lifetime Achievement Award by IAPSM at the 21st Joint IAPSM and IPHA Maharashtra State Conference and IAPSM Young Leaders' Conclave, DMIMS, Wardha, 5 - 7 Feb 2020.
- Dr. Dilip Gupta, Director Professor and Head, Surgery, was awarded Honorary Fellowship of Association of Surgeons of India - FAIS at National Conference in Bhubaneswar in 2019 December. He has also been Elected as National Vice President of Association of Rural Surgeons of India for the period 2019-2022.
- Dr. K.K. Mishra, Professor and Head, Department of Psychiatry has taken over the charge as Treasurer Indian Psychiatry Society.
- Dr. Abhay Deshmukh, Assistant Professor, Pathology has been awarded best Teacher award 2020 by the Institute of Scholars, Bangalore in recognition of his valuable contribution to the academic community and the students.

- Ms Cheryl Mankar 2016 batch attended International conference for Healthcare and Medical students, organized by Royal college of Surgeons - Ireland, Dublin from 6th to 8th Feb 2020 and presented her work. Mr. Sujay Shrivatsava, 2016 batch student was also selected to present his research work at the same conference but could not attend due to personal issues.

Postgraduate

- Dr. Asha Purohit, PG Obst and Gynae got 3rd Prize in AICOG Lucknow in paper presentations amongst 236 papers
- Dr. Subhashree Page, PG Surgery bagged 2nd Prize in Poster Competition at the 42nd Annual conference of Maharashtra chapter of Association of Surgeons of India, held at Amravati from 23rd- 26th Jan 2020 and Dr. Saurav Uplenchwar also won Best Poster Award at the 27th Annual conference of Association of Rural Surgeons of India, at Bagalkot Karnataka.

Item No.08 : To report about the admissions of Postgraduate Courses (MD/MS) for the academic year 2020-2021

This year we have admitted 64 candidates in various postgraduate courses (MD/MS) for the academic year 2020-2021. The PG students were selected by DGHS/DMER on the basis of NEET PG-2019 examination. No candidates were selected in the subjects of Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry and forensic Medicine. As this is the 3rd consecutive year when there are no admissions in these subjects, MCI will be approached to provide continuation of recognition to these degrees.

Item No.09 : To report about the position of admission to first Year MBBS course for the academic session 2020-2021

The admission process for the academic session 2020-2021 for first year MBBS course has not been started till date due to Covid-2019 pandemic. The postponed NEET-2020 examination was held on 13th September 2020 and the results are expected in mid-October.
